An old game can be used as a management-training.

This has been a reason for using the game 2000 years ago in order to find executive managers.

In a workshop for two or three days with around four members, the Polo Academy focuses not only on the game, but using this game as management training tool. Managers are accompanied by Hurlingham Polo Coaches and an external management coach in order to learn the idea of the game and to improve their performance in the job.

In the early mornings and in the early evenings individual coaching on the job is offered.

We build bridges between learning a game and applying this knowledge to a business environment.
